Functions of the SCC:

1. Mentoring and Guidance:

- Provide academic counselling to students to help them meet their academic goals.

2. Address Student Concerns:

- The committee serves as a confidential platform for students to voice their concerns and seek guidance.

3. Monitoring and Reporting:

- Monitor the progress of students receiving counselling and ensure follow-up support.
- Prepare and maintain reports on the counselling sessions, ensuring students' issues are documented and addressed.

4. Collaboration with Other Committees:

- Work with the Anti-Ragging Committee, Disciplinary Committee, and Other Student Welfare Bodies to ensure a holistic approach to student welfare.

Counselling Procedure:

- Students can request counselling sessions either by submitting a formal request to the committee or through the Mentor-Mentee System.
- The confidentiality of student concerns is maintained throughout the process.
- The committee ensures that each student receives the necessary guidance, and action plans are created as needed.

Frequency of Meetings:

- The SCC meets atleast once every semester to discuss the progress of counselling sessions and to review any emerging student concerns.
